Bonjour à toutes et à tous! C'est vendredi -- et les vacances!

For those of you planning to participate in the Fête Française, we would like to remind you of a few things:

1. **NOTE A CHANGE.....PLEASE** use the utmost care when determining the level at which to register your students. With more and more francophones in our area, we want to encourage their participation, but keep Fête fair, equitable, and fun for all. Refer to the general regulations (on our website) to aid in the **proper placement for each level. There are some changes. Students in level 1-2-3 should be registered either in category A or B. Also, please review the advantaged speaker's requirements.**
2. **French Club T-shirt:** Limit of 1 entry per school
 - a) T-shirt will count for school points only.
 - b) **Artwork must be designed by a student; no catalogue designs can be entered.**
 - c) All artwork on the shirt will be judged (including front/back/sleeve artwork).
 - d) Subject of entry must be school appropriate.
 - e) The t-shirt entered should be the current year's French Club t-shirt
3. NO **QPC (Questions pour un Champion) event** for this year.
4. The Music video and skit video need to be dropped-off the morning of the competition.
5. The master schedule remains the same as last year. We will send you a master schedule with the room number for each event in January once completed.
6. Make sure you've sent in your **AATF membership dues!** You will not be allowed to register your students if you are not a member. Also, each teacher at a school who is bringing students to Fête must be a member of AATF.
7. All teachers bringing students to Fête have to judge at least 1 event. Please register with Anne Jones. See information below.
8. Confirm your judging assignment with Anne Jones (or propose others). Nous avons besoin de vous et vos amis francophones!
